

ORDINANCE NO. 3 – 2014

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF GREENWICH
AMENDING SECTION 12 OF CHAPTER 120
ADDRESSING HEALTH AND INSURANCE
BENEFITS FOR RETIREES**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
GREENWICH AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Purpose

To correct a clerical error and clarify and update certain standards and regulations in regards to benefits for retirees. This shall not impact existing employees but only those hired after April 15, 2013.

Section 2. Repeal:

Chapter 120, Section 12. C. (3) is hereby repealed and replaced with the amended language below. In all other respects Chapter 120 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 2. Amendment

Section 12 C. (3) of Chapter 120 is amended to read as follows:

§120-12 C. (3)

A person under the age of 65 and retired after 25 years of full-time employment shall be covered by the Greenwich Township health insurance program as primary coverage until that person reaches 65 years of age, or is otherwise eligible for coverage under Medicare. Upon such person becoming eligible for coverage under Medicare, such person shall elect Medicare as his/her primary medical insurance benefit with the Greenwich Township health benefit plan being secondary.

Section 3. Effective This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after adoption and publication as required by law.

Introduced at a regular meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Township of Greenwich held on the 21st day of April, 2014 and passed upon a second reading of the Mayor and Council held on the 20th of May, 2014.
