TIME. THE FOLLOWING WILL BE THE SCHEDULE FOR FALL BULK  
LEAF PICK-UP.

THURSDAY	NOVEMBER 10, 2014 DECEMBER 8, 2014

Please rake your leaves to the curb and gutter on you're scheduled week.  
You can bag them if you wish.

Grass and garden wastes may also be put out.

**PLEASE DO NOT BLOCK DRAINAGE FLOW. PLEASE DO NOT PARK  
CARS ON LEAF PILES. PLEASE DO NOT PUT TREE BRANCHES IN  
LEAF PILES**

The Holiday's may create a delay in Leaf Collection.

While we are collecting leaves, the Collection of Brush  
will be delayed until all of the leaves have been collected.  
Your patience and understanding will be greatly appreciated.

**After December 29, 2014, all grass, leaves, and  
vegetative waste must be bagged for collection.**

**As a reminder to residents that have contractors (i.e.: landscapers or lawn  
maintenance persons) doing their clean-ups, by township ordinance, Contractors  
are required to remove and dispose of the debris outside of the township.**
